For all awards, nominations must be submitted via SharePoint to the University Graduate School. Nominations must come from a department or school. Student self-nominations will not be accepted.

Application/Nomination Process

Students must submit their applications and required materials to their school/department. Please refer students to our website, <http://www.graduate.indiana.edu/admissions/financial-support/fellowships-awards/index.shtml>, to access the award/fellowship applications.

All schools/departments have their own internal student application deadline for each award/fellowship competition. The University Graduate School deadlines are for schools/departments ONLY.

The school/department is responsible for reviewing the applications received and making the determination if they wish to nominate the candidate for the award. It's the school/departments responsibility to make sure all required material has been received and included in the nomination.

Nominations must be submitted through SharePoint by the school/department. To submit a nomination, log onto SharePoint: <https://www.sharepoint.iu.edu/sites/UGSAwardsAndFellowships/default.aspx>. Step by step instructions can be found on our website and in the Resources tab on the SharePoint site.

Schools/Departments are responsible for contacting the candidates that have applied, but were not chosen for nomination.
